Policy for Continuity of Coverage

Individual Plan or Insurance Broker Portfolio Plans

Continuity of coverage will be provided for people wishing to migrate to the Plan Santa Fe Plus upon submission of the following documents:

- Full copy of their current plan.
- Daily Claim of their current plan.
- Undergo medical exams according to age.
- Complete the application and submit a copy of the ID card.

Colective Insurance

Continuity of coverage will be provided for portfolios wishing to migrate to the Plan Santa Fe Plus, upon submission of the following documents:

- Complete the applications and submit copies of the ID cards.
- Contracting Party's Know Your Customer Form.
- Copy of the Legal Representative's ID card.
- Daily Claim for each collective insured.
- Full copy of the current plan.
- Business Operating License

Plan Familiar o Plan Tercera Edad

Continuity of coverage will be provided to insured individuals requesting the new program, under the following guidelines:

- Complete the application and submit an updated copy of the ID card.
- Individual evaluation of each case by the Medical Director, who has access to the client's history.

Pregnant Women

Pregnant women will not be accepted. They may apply for the health plan 3 months after giving birth.

Plan Santa Fe Plus (from RAL B/. 150k to RAL B/. 200k)

When the client wants to change from RAL 150k to 200k while maintaining continuity, or vice versa, it will be handled as follows:

A new plan will be issued for both cases:

- If it is a downgrade, we will process it.
- If it is an upgrade, the client must acquire a new plan and undergo pre-entry medical exams again. The 12-month waiting period applies.
